GRAND CHAMPION POINTS & AWARDS OF MERIT

Grand Championship points will be awarded at the judge's discretion to AKC champions of record for the placements: Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog, Select Bitch.

Up to four (4) Awards of Merit may be given for additional recognition of dogs and/or bitches competing in Best of Breed Competition - at the judge's option, in any quantity regardless of sex. Best of Breed, Best of Winners, and Best of Opposite Sex are excluded from AOM selections by virtue of their higher placement.

CLASSIFICATION

REGULAR CLASSES (Classes for Dogs and Bitches)

- Puppy, 6 mos. and under 9 mos.
- Puppy, 9 mos. and under 12 mos.
- 12 mos. and under 18 mos.
- Novice
- Bred By Exhibitor
- American Bred
- Open
- Winners
- BEST OF BREED

NOTE: Bred By Exhibitor (BBE) Class Eligibility (revision 9-02)

1. All dogs entered in the Bred by Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC, AS OF THE DATE OF THE EVENT. (Eff. 1-1-10)
2. The person handling the dog must be both a breeder of record and an owner of record of the dog.
3. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a registered breeder and owner of record.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES - SINGLE DOG ENTRIES - for BOTH Dogs and Bitches

Veteran Class - For dogs seven (7) years of age and older. Judging of Veteran Classes will be after Winners Dog and Winners Bitch. Winners of these classes will be eligible for Best of Breed competition.

NOTE: AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows. Chapter 11. Section 8. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veterans Classes only at independent specialties and/or those all-breed shows which do not offer any competitive classes beyond Best of Breed. This is an independent specialty.

[NEW] Earthdog Class - Offered for Wire Fox Terriers six (6) months of age and older that have earned an AKC Earthdog title including Junior Earthdog, Senior Earthdog, Master Earthdog. Introduction to Quarry does not qualify. It is not necessary for an Earthdog Class entrant to be entered in any other class. Judging of Earthdog Class will be after Winners Dog and Winners Bitch. The winners of each class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed. Neutered and Spayed dogs are not eligible for competition in this class.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES - MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Stud Dog Class - For Stud Dogs and two (2) or more of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog class and shown in the ring with his Get. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the Regular or Non-Regular classes at the regular entry fee of \$30, with 'Stud Dog' class indicated on the entry form in the space for additional classes at an additional \$10. Or, the Stud Dog may be entered in Stud Dog class ONLY for a \$30 entry fee.

The Get MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes, but there is no additional entry fee for them as participants with their sire in this non-regular class. The Get only will be judged, on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or being excused under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for the Breed.

NOTE: AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows. Chapter 11. Section 8. A castrated male may be entered as Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

STUD DOG & BROOD BITCH ARE PERMITTED TO BE CLIPPED AND NOT STRIPPED.

THIS DOES NOT APPLY TO THE GET.

Brood Bitch Class - Same as Stud Dog Class except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog, Produce for Get.

Brace Class - Effective January 1, 2005. A brace is defined by AKC as two (2) dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner. The dogs comprising the Brace must be named at the time of the entry. Entry fee is \$30 for the pair if this is the only class in which they are entered; specify 'Brace Only' on the entry form. If a dog that is to be part of a Brace is entered in another class, specify 'Brace Class' in the 'Additional Entry' section on the entry form; the fee is \$10. If one or both are also entered in a regular class, then the entry fee is \$10.

Team Class - same as Brace except substitute 'Team' for 'Brace', and Four (4) in place of Two (2) dogs.



PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

The Wire Fox Terrier Club of the Central States Sweepstakes is open to all breeders and owners of Wire Fox Terriers, to be judged before the Regular Classes. All dogs shown in the Sweepstakes MUST be shown by the owner, breeder, or an amateur. No AKC Champions of record are eligible. Dogs shown in Sweepstakes must also be entered in one of the Regular Classes at the regular entry fee and on the regular entry form. Indicate Sweepstakes class with the age division in the space provided for 'Additional Classes'. Entry fee for the Sweepstakes class is \$20.

CLASSIFICATION (Classes for Dogs and Bitches)

- Puppy, 6 months and under 9 months
- Puppy, 9 months and under 12 months
- Junior, 12 months and under 18 months

PRIZE MONEY

The amount of money received from Sweepstakes entry fees will be divided as follows:

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to all Wire Fox Terriers, 7 years of age and older on the date of the show. Champions of Record are eligible. All class winners will compete for Best Veteran in Sweepstakes. Veteran Sweepstakes must be noted on the entry form; entry fee is \$20. Veteran Sweepstakes entrants need not be entered in a regular class, and are permitted to be clipped and not stripped.

CLASSIFICATION (Classes for Dogs and Bitches)

- Veteran 7 years and older, under 10 years
- Veteran 10 years of age and over

PRIZE MONEY

The amount of money received from entry fees will be divided as follows:

First Place in class	40%	Third Place in class.....	20%
Second Place in class	30%	Fourth Place in class	10%

In the event fewer than 4 dogs entered in a division, the balance of the percentage money for that division will be divided among those entries in that division.



FUTURITY

JUDGE: Mrs. Susan Carter Nowicki

The Futurity stake is a breeder's classic of the Wire Fox Terriers Club of the Central States and is comparable to the Kentucky Derby for breeders of top running horses. The word 'futurity' implies looking into the future. In the case of the WFTCCS this means a conscientious attempt to ensure future excellence in the breed. Much time and effort has been expended in the past toward the development of the breed as we know it today; the Futurity Program is a means for recognizing the efforts of sincere breeders for continued improvement.

'Futurity' can also imply a challenge or a gamble on the future. As a breeder selects a certain Bitch to be bred to a certain Stud, he or she is expressing an opinion that this breeding will produce offspring of desired conformation and character, offspring that will win in competition over the offspring of other breedings that are enrolled in the Futurity Program.

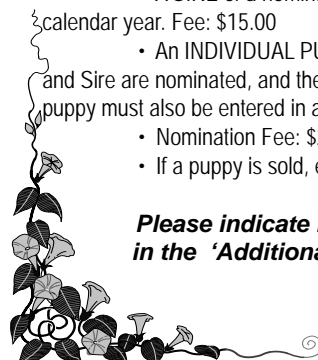
To back up this faith in his/her own judgment, the breeder pays money into a fund that will be divided among the winners of the Futurity. The prize fund for each year's winning Futurity competitors will be comprised of:

1. Monies from nominated Bitches (Litters) and Stud Dogs.
2. Monies from individually nominated puppies from these eligible litters
3. Monies from entry fees paid for the specialty futurity entries. AKC requires that each entry in an AKC show must be on an official entry form complete with disclaimers.

ELIGIBILITY

- The Futurity is open to all AKC registered and AKC recognized foreign registered Wire Fox Terriers.
- A DAM may be nominated after the Bitch is bred and before the litter is whelped. Only the breeder of record may nominate a Dam. This nomination constitutes a 'litter nomination' and makes all puppies in that litter eligible for individual nomination, provided the Sire has also been nominated.
- A Bitch/Litter Nomination Fee of \$15.00 will be included with the submitted nomination.
- A SIRE of a nominated litter may be nominated at any time during the calendar year. Fee: \$15.00
- An INDIVIDUAL PUPPY can be nominated at any time, but only if its Dam and Sire are nominated, and the puppy is nominated before the age of 6 months. This puppy must also be entered in a regular class at the show.
- Nomination Fee: \$25.00, which includes the entry fee for Futurity Class.
- If a puppy is sold, eligibility will continue to the new owner.

MISCELLANEOUS FUTURITY RULES AND INFORMATION

- Individual PUPPY nominations for a particular specialty must be received by the Futurity Director 8 weeks prior to the show.
- All nomination fees are paid to the WFTCCS, no refunds will be made.
- Futurity classes will be held on the Friday before the specialty and will have a breeder judge.
- All Futurity entries must also be entered in a regular class at the specialty.
- A professional handler may exhibit only if they are the breeder/owner of the dog they are showing.
- Champions of Record are eligible to compete.
- Ongoing nominations of Dams and Sires will be published in WFTCCS newsletters.
- Results of each Futurity will be published for members and exhibitors, and archived, to be published in future catalogs.

FUTURITY CLASSES *(for dogs and bitches)*

SENIOR DIVISION

Dogs 15 months of age, under 18 months
Dogs 12 months of age, under 15 months

JUNIOR DIVISION

Dogs 9 months of age, under 12 months
Dogs 6 months of age, under 9 months

JUDGING

Dogs and bitches will be judged separately, then the winners from each class within a division (max. 4) will return for Junior Division Winner. Senior Division Winner will be judged in the same manner. The winners of each division will then return to the ring for the selection of the Grand Futurity Winner.

FUTURITY PRIZE MONEY

35% of total monies will be retained for expenses. Of the remaining monies, 3% will go to the owner of the Sire of the Grand Futurity Winner, 5% will go to the Breeder of the Grand Futurity Winner, and 7% will go to the Owner of the Grand Futurity Winner. The remaining monies will be divided as follows for the classes.

Best of Breed.

The Wire Fox Terrier Club of the Central States offers for competition at this show only, for Best of Breed, the **GEORGE WARD MEMORIAL TROPHY** for the BREEDER OF THE BEST OF BREED WIRE, a **Statue of a Wire Fox Terrier Mounted on a Walnut Base**. This trophy shall have the breeders name and the name of the best of breed dog for that year affixed to the base. For permanent possession, the trophy must be won three times by the same breeder, but not necessarily with the same dog, nor at consecutive shows.

Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed.

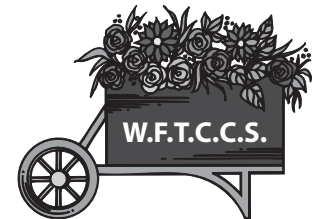

- No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 ft. of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.

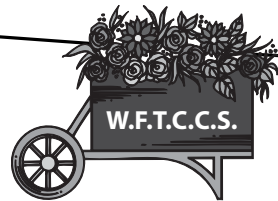
