NOTE: Bred by Exhibitor (BBE) Class Eligibility (AKC revision 9-02)

1. Dogs entered in Bred by Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with AKC, as of the closing date of the show.
2. The person handling the dog must be both a breeder of record and an owner of record of the dog.
3. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

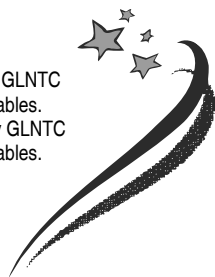

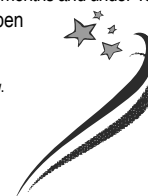

Manchester Terriers (standard, toy). Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat). English Toy Spaniels (King Charles & Ruby, Blenheim & Prince Charles). Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition. 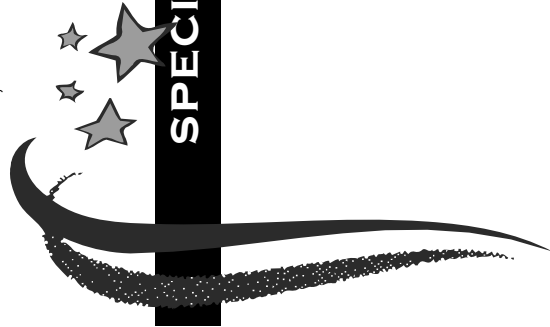
