Following Sweepstakes, there will be a **1-1/2 hour LUNCH BREAK**. When the break begins, an announcement of judging start-up time will be made and posted.

At approx. 1:30 pm or the conclusion of the Lunch Break, the Parade of Veterans will be held.

Following the Parade, judging will resume in Ring One with Junior Showmanship, followed by Breed Classes, through their conclusion.

The PUPPY MATCH will be held 1/2 hour after judging concludes.

Immediately following the conclusion of Sweepstakes, Junior Showmanship classes will be judged, then Dog Classes through Veteran Dogs.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW SITE

From North to South: Take US23 to I-96 (West bound East of Brighton). Exit 147 (Spencer Road) turn right, into Brighton, go straight through light. You are now on Main Street in Brighton, this becomes Brighton Road just outside of town. Continue to Chilson Road, left (South) on Chilson about 1/2 mile to Bishop Lake Road (on right), turn right on Bishop Lake Road, go about 1/2 mile to show site in park.

From Kensing Inn, Howell: South on Pinckney Road 4 miles to Coon Lake Road, left on Coon Lake Rd, 3 1/2 miles to Chilson Road. Right on Chilson Road, 2 1/2 miles South to Bishop Lake Road on right, turn right, go 1/2 mile to show site in park.

From Chicago: I-94 East to Hwy 14 which becomes Hwy 23, North on US 23 to I-96, then as above.

From Detroit Airport: I-94 West to US 23 around city of Ann Arbor, then as above North.
