**Judge's Awards of Merit

Awards of Merit will be made available for the recognition of dogs and/or bitches competing in Best of Breed Competition that are not awarded Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex, or Best of Opposite Sex. Awards are not to exceed 5% of the total entries in the regular breed classes and may be awarded only at the judge's discretion. The number of awards available will be limited to a maximum of five (5), but will include AKC Grand Champion Selects Dog 1 and Bitch 1. At the judges option, Grand Champion Select Points may be awarded to the First AOM Dog and First AOM Bitch (Select Dog 1 and Select Bitch 1). Club policy is that there will be 1 Award of Merit available for entries of 20-39; 2 awards for 40-59; 3 awards for 60-79; 4 awards for 80-99; 5 for entries of 100 or more.

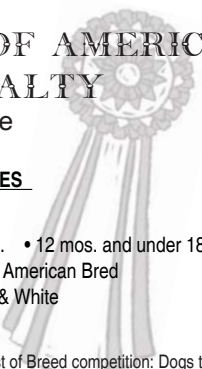
Best of Breed: The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90-day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC.

Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one-half hour prior to the start of judging at the Show.

- NOTE: Bred By Exhibitor (BBE) Class Eligibility (AKC revision 1-1-10)**
1. Dogs entered in Bred by Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with AKC, as of the date of the show.
 2. The person handling the dog must be both a breeder of record and an owner of record of the dog

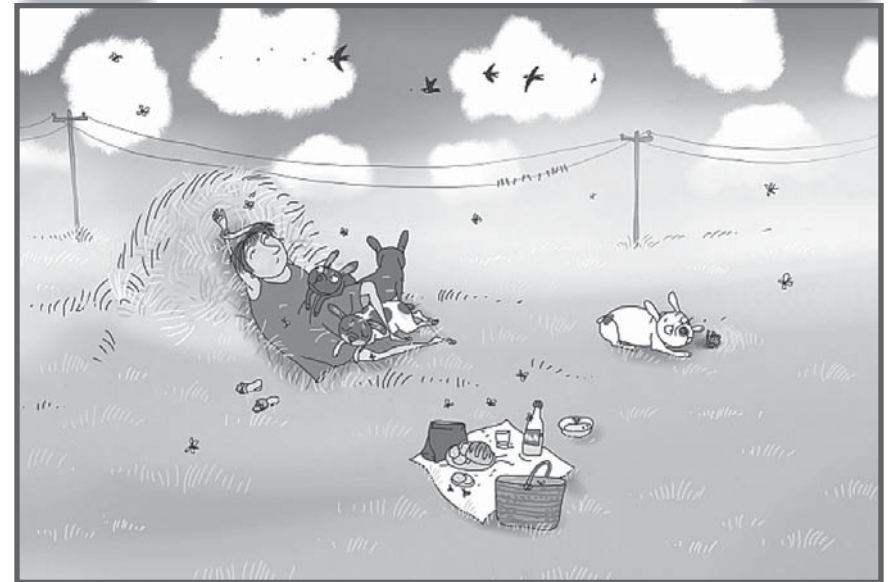

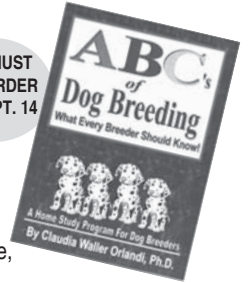

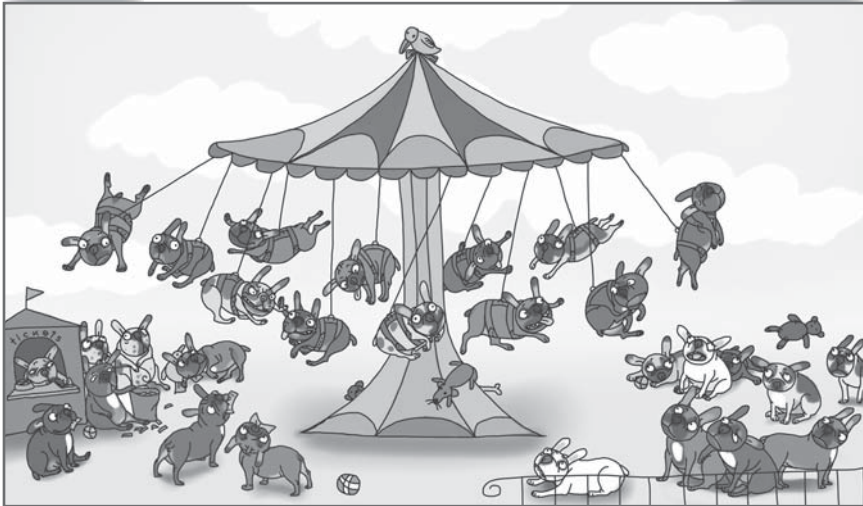

- Open Cream & Fawn
- Open Pied & White
- BEST OF BREED

Best of Breed: The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90-day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC.

Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed competition, provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent at least one-half hour prior to the start of judging at the Show.

NOTE: Bred By Exhibitor (BBE) Class Eligibility (AKC revision 1-1-10)

1. Dogs entered in Bred by Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with AKC, as of the date of the show.
2. The person handling the dog must be both a breeder of record and an owner of record of the dog
3. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES - SINGLE DOG ENTRIES - (Classes for both Dogs and Bitches)

Veteran Class: (Entry Fee \$20.) • 7-9 years • 9 years and older on the day of the show

NOTE: AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows. Chapter 11. Section 8. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veteran Classes only at independent specialties and/or those all-breed shows which do not offer any competitive classes beyond Best of Breed. This is an independent specialty.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES - MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES - (Classes for both Dogs and Bitches)

Stud Dog Class: For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and shown in the ring with their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owner of the Get. The Get must be entered individually in one of the regular classes, Best of Breed, or some non-regular class other than Stud Dog. Judging will be based on merits of the Get.

NOTE: The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the Regular or Non-Regular classes at the first entry fee of \$25., with 'Stud Dog' class indicated on the entry form in the space for additional classes at an additional \$20. OR, the Stud Dog may be entered in Stud Dog class only for a \$20. entry fee.

Brood Bitch Class: Same as Stud Dog Class except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

NOTE: "Chapter 11, Section 8 of the "Rules Applying to Dog Shows" provides that a neutered male may be entered as a Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed Bitch may be entered as a Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

As the Judge's decision in the **Stud Dog, Brood Bitch and Brace Classes** will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

Brace Class: Each Brace shall be composed of two French Bulldogs, irrespective of sex, owned by an identical owner. Entry fee is \$20. for the unit. If the dog that is part of the Brace is not entered in another Class, it must be entered for "Brace Class Only". Show Brace Class in "Additional Entry" portion of the entry form. If more than one Brace is entered by identical owner, the dog comprising each Brace Unit must be designated "Brace#1", "Brace#2, Etc.

NOTE: Effective January 1, 2005. A brace is defined by AKC as two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner.

Judge: Dorit Fischler, DVM

The Breeders Class is a new AKC "Special Attraction" established to showcase successful breeders, and is offered only at independent specialty shows. This event is unique in that the entry must be made by the Breeder or Co-Breeder. The basis for the judging in this class is the consistency and superior quality of the breeder's entry, a group of from 3 to 5 dogs (the "unit"). It will be judged as the very last event of the National Specialty, following non-regular classes. Entry Fee: \$25.

HOW CAN I ENTER THIS RELATIVELY NEW SPECIAL ATTRACTION EVENT?

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. All dogs MUST be entered in another regular or non-regular class in the 2011 National Specialty. This will be verified. Dogs who are entered in the unit but who are NOT entered in another regular or non-regular class at this show will prevent the entire UNIT from being shown.
2. Neutered and Spayed French Bulldogs ARE eligible to be entered in this unit, but must then be entered in the Specialty in the only other classes that permit this (Veteran, Stud Dog, Brood Bitch).
