2020 S. Custer Road, Monroe, MI 48161

US-23 to M-50 exit (Tecumseh/Dundee). Go EAST  
on M-50 for approximately a 10-15 minute drive.  
Fairgrounds are on the south side of the road.

## NOTICES FOR EXHIBITORS

### TROPHIES & AWARDS

- All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - none will be mailed. The club reserves the right to substitute unavailable prizes with ones of equal or greater value.
- Class monetary prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before exiting, and the Show Secretary's Office advised at once. The Show Secretary and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for monetary prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

### JUDGING/EXHIBITING

- Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
- Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show giving club and the Show Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought in the ring when required.
- A refund of all but \$4.00 of the entry fee will be made to any exhibitor with a bitch entered in obedience classes who comes in season after entries close. To be eligible for a refund, a statement from a veterinarian must be presented to the Show Secretary before 8:00 a.m. on the day of the show.

### SHOW SITE

- NO PRACTICING ALLOWED IN RINGS AT ANY TIME.
- All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to crates except when being judged or in an exercise pen.
- No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of judging. No private exercise pens permitted in the parking area.
- All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against the Alaskan Malamute Club of America and its members, in the event that a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog that appears to be in stress such as from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.
- The Club, their officers and members, show secretary and any employees of said Club or Secretary will not be responsible for any disappearance, loss, theft, injury, or other harm to dogs or personal property for any cause at any time. The Club further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.
