35% of entry fees will be retained by the club to defer expenses; 20% of entry fees designated for Best in Sweepstakes60% Best of Opposite in Sweepstakes 40%

Remaining monies (45%) will be divided as follows:

1st place in Sweeps Class	40% of entry fees of that class

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Sweepstakes is open to all purebred Labrador Retrievers who are six (6) months and under 18 months of age on the day of the show. All dogs entered in Sweepstakes must also be entered in a Regular Class at the regular entry fee. Indicate Sweepstakes as an additional class with the age division in the space provided for 'Additional Classes'. (Entry fee \$20)

VETERAN SWEEPSTAKES

Veteran Sweepstakes is open to any purebred Labrador Retriever seven (7) years of age and over on the day of the show. Dogs entered in Veteran Sweepstakes need NOT be entered in any other classes. Champions of record are eligible as are spayed and neutered Labradors. Select the appropriate 'Sweepstakes' class on the entry form. (Entry fee \$20)

NOTE: Amateur-Owner-Handler (AOH) - For dogs that are at least six (6) months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner, and this class is limited to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler (eff. 1-1-09)

NOTE: Bred By Exhibitor (BBE) Class Eligibility (AKC revision 9-02)

1. Dogs entered in Bred by Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with AKC, as of the closing date for the show.
2. The person handling the dog must be both a breeder of record and an owner of record of the dog.
3. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES - SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Veteran Classes - for Dogs and Bitches (Entry Fee \$20)

- 7-9 years old on the day of the show
- 9 years and older on the day of the show

NOTE: AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows. Chapter 11. Section 8. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veterans Classes only at independent specialties and/or those all-breed shows which do not offer any competitive classes beyond Best of Breed. This is an independent specialty. Winners of the Veteran classes are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed ring.

Hunting Retriever Classes - for Dogs and Bitches (Entry Fee \$20)

- for Dogs and Bitches who have earned an AKC Junior, Senior, Master Hunter Title. Entrants in these classes may not be altered. Winners of the Hunting Retriever Classes are eligible to compete in the Best of Breed ring.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES - MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Stud Dog Class - For Stud Dogs and TWO of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog class and shown in the ring with his Get. The Stud Dog may also be entered separately in one of the Regular Classes at the regular entry fee of \$26, with 'Stud Dog' class indicated on the entry form as an additional entry, at \$20 additional fee.

The Get MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes, but there is no additional entry fee for them as participants with their sire in this non-regular class. The Get only will be judged, on the merit of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or being excused under the Dog Show rules, AKC policy or the standard for the Breed.

Brood Bitch Class - Same as Stud Dog Class except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog, Produce for Get.

NOTE: AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows. Chapter 11. Section 8. A castrated male may be entered as Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

Manchester Terriers (standard, toy). Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat). English Toy Spaniels (King Charles & Ruby, Blenheim & Prince Charles). Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition. Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs, which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog i.e., age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. - **Make All Checks and Money Orders payable** to Specialty Dog Shows in U.S. funds only. Please send only checks or money orders; the Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.
- A \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee and a \$.50 Recording Fee will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member club show. These are included in the Entry Fees. Event Service and Recording fees are to be collected by the Show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show. Fees are to be collected on each entry, except sweepstakes, junior showmanship and multiple dog non-regular classes (American Kennel Club rule, Chapter 11, Section 2.)
- No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.
- **Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event** that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the event's Show Committee.
