**DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW**  
Monroe County Fairgrounds  
2020 S. Custer Road, Monroe, MI 48161

**From the North or South** take I-75 to Exit 15 (M-50). Go WEST for approximately a 10-15 minute drive.  
**Alternate route:** From the North or South take US-23 to M-50 exit (Tecumseh/Dundee). Go EAST on M-50 for approximately a 10-15 minute drive. Fairgrounds are on the south side of the road.  
Most roads in S. E. Michigan are subject to construction during the warmer months. Frequent lane closures may cause lengthy delays - Allow extra travel time!

**HOW TO FIND US**

**The HRLRC Conformation Ring is located under the tent next to the fencing at the front end of the grounds (toward M-50) past the RV area. This is the North end.**

**Obedience judging is in the Rabbit Building, which is at the opposite (south) end of the big main tent where the majority of the rings are.**

**TROPHIES & AWARDS**

- All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - none will be mailed. The club reserves the right to substitute unavailable prizes with ones of equal or greater value.  
- Class monetary prizes will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before exiting, and the Show Secretary's Office advised at once. The Show Secretary and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for monetary prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

**JUDGING/EXHIBITING**

- Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.  
- Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show giving club and the Show Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought in the ring when required.  
- A refund of all but \$4.00 of the entry fee will be made to any exhibitor with a bitch entered in obedience classes who comes in season after entries close. To be eligible for a refund, a statement from a veterinarian must be presented to the Show Secretary before 8:00 a.m. on the day of the show.

**SHOW SITE**

- NO PRACTICING ALLOWED IN RINGS AT ANY TIME.  
- All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to crates except when being judged or in an exercise pen.  
- No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of judging. No private exercise pens permitted in the parking area.  
- All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against the Huron River Labrador Club and its members, in the event that a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog that appears to be in stress such as from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.

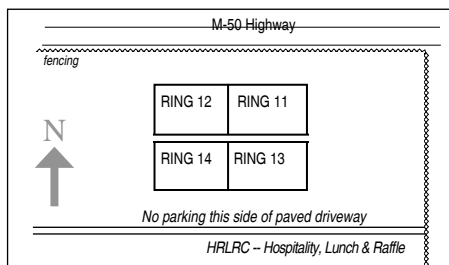
