AN AKC WATER TEST WILL ALSO BE OFFERED EACH DAY.

Effective 1-1-11, *Regulations for AKC Hunting Tests for Pointing Breeds*, Chapter 2, Sections 3 & 4 amendment. . . a Spinone Italiano shall not be recorded a Senior Hunter (or Master Hunter) unless it has also been certified by two approved field trial or hunting test judges to have passed an AKC Water Test at a licensed or member field trial or hunting test.

Chapter 2, page 13 . . . (Water Test) shall be open to all pointing breeds six months of age or over on the first day of the event. The Water Test shall be judged by two approved field trial or hunting test judges. The dog shall retrieve a dead game bird from the water after a swim of about 20 yards to the water, and the dog must demonstrate its willingness to enter the water, to swim, and to retrieve, at the direction of its handler without being touched or intimidated. Style shall not be considered. The dogs shall not be placed, but shall either pass or fail. The Judges shall certify on the judging sheets the particulars of each dog that passed the test. Dogs passing the test will receive a ribbon award.

Water Test Entry Fee: \$10. To enter, check Water Test on your Hunt Test Entry Form (next page).
Judges for each Water Test will be those listed Hunt Test judges for the day.

All dogs passing the Water Test will receive an orange rosette.

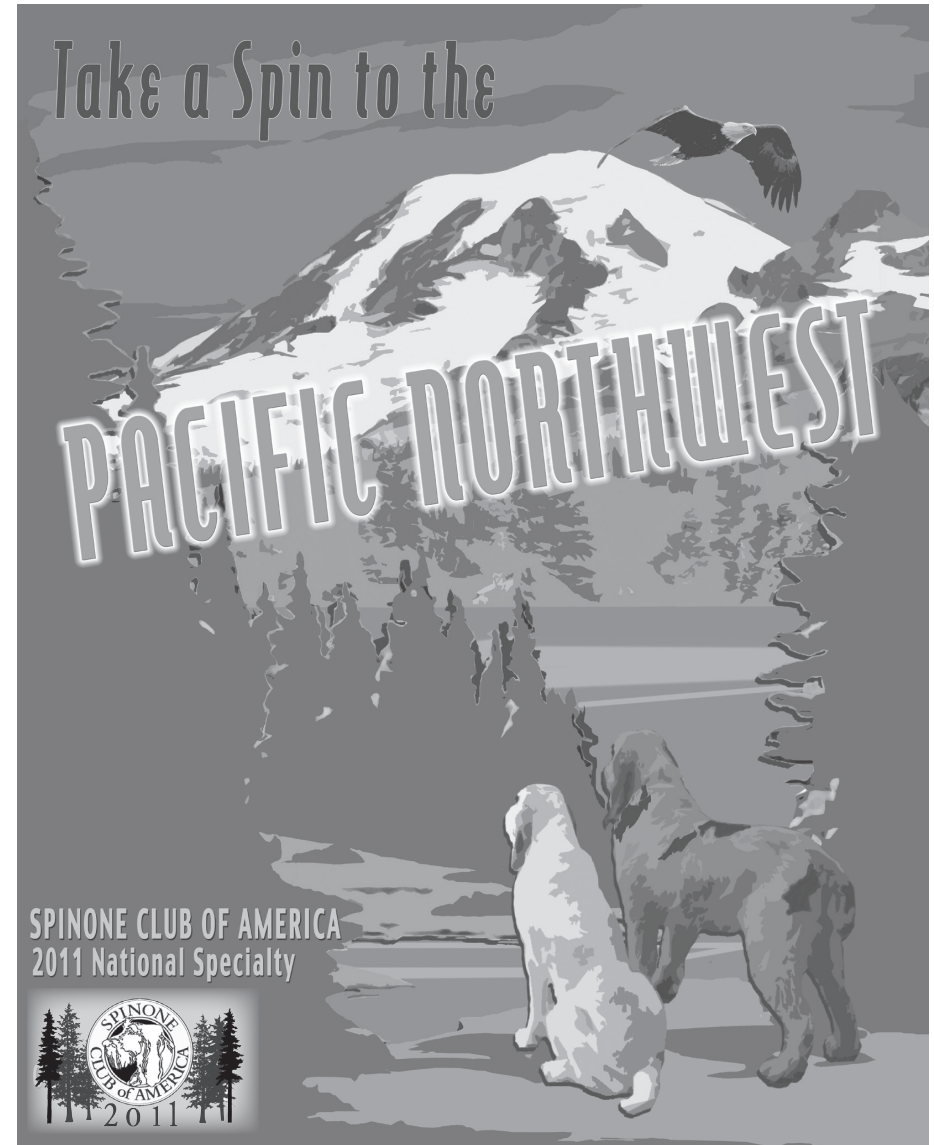
