### DIRECTIONS

#### TO THE HOTEL & DINNER -

**From US-23 headed south:** Take M-14 west to Exit #2 (Miller/Maple Road). Turn left at the stop sign on to Maple. At the 4th traffic light turn right on to Jackson Road. The Best Western is 1/3 mile on the right.

**From US-23 headed north:** Take US-23 north to I-94 west. Exit at Exit #172 (Jackson Road). The Best Western is less than 1/4 mile on the right.

**From I-94 headed east:** Take I-94 east to Exit #172 (Ann Arbor). As you come off the exit it will merge directly on to Jackson Road. The Best Western is approximately 100 yards on the left.

**From I-94 headed west:** Take I-94 west to Exit #172 (Jackson Road). Turn left at the traffic light on to Jackson Road. The Best Western is less than 1/4 mile on the right.

**TO THE SHOW SITE (Ann Arbor Dog Training Club) from the hotel** - Turn left out of the parking lot and head east to Maple Road (you will pass under I-94 expressway). Turn left on Maple Road to M-14, take M-14 east to US-23 north (towards Flint). Take US-23 to the North Territorial Road exit. Turn right and head east on North Territorial Road until you reach the railroad tracks and Carter Lumber Co. The entry drive to the show site (A.A.D.T.C) is on your left just past the lumber company.

# SHOW REGULATIONS

## GUEST ROOMS

- Hotels are becoming increasingly difficult to obtain. Please respect these premises and their staff. The hotel requires that all dogs be caged at all times in the guest room.
- Please put plastic under your crates in your room. Do not groom in any guest room.

## TROPHIES & AWARDS

- All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - none will be mailed. The club reserves the right to substitute unavailable prizes with ones of equal or greater value.
- Class MONETARY PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging is over, and the Show Secretary's Office advised at once. The Show Secretary and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging is over.

## JUDGING & EXHIBITING

- **Dogs may arrive any time** prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
- **Judges will not wait** for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

## SHOW SITE

- PRACTICING IS NOT ALLOWED IN THE RINGS AT ANY TIME
- Exercise pens will be allowed at the discretion of the Show Committee.
- All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to crates except when being judged or in an exercise pen.
- No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of judging.
- **All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages** against the Cairn Terrier Club of Greater Detroit and its members, in the event that a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog that appears to be in stress such as from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.
- The Club, their officers and members, show secretary and any employees of said Club or Secretary will not be responsible for any disappearance, loss, theft, injury, or other harm to dogs or personal property for any cause at any time. The Club further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. PARENTS & GUARDIANS MUST KEEP THEIR CHILDREN UNDER CONTROL ON THE SHOW GROUNDS.
