DIRECTIONS TO THE HOST HOTEL:

From the South (on I-81) - exit 52A, turn rt. on US-11 (Harrisburg Pike). The 2nd road on the right is Embers Dr., Turn rt. to hotel and convention center.
From North on I-81 - exit 52, left onto US-11, then follow above.
From East or West on I-76 (Pennsylvania Turnpike) - exit at #226 which takes you to US-11 (Harrisburg Pike). Turn left or N and follow the road, crossing I-81, past Cook Dr. of rt. Turn right at next street (Embers Dr.) and follow to hotel and convention center.

DIRECTIONS TO THE HUNT TEST FROM THE HOTEL & SHOW SITE [27 miles; approx. 37 min.]:

Head west on Harrisburg Pike 1.5 miles to get onto I-76 E (Turnpike - toll road).
Go 10.5 miles and get off at #236. Keep right at the fork toward US-15 and merge onto US-15-S. Go 6.7 mi.
Turn left at N. Baltimore St. (PA-74-S). 1.7 mi.
Turn left at Carlisle Rd. (PA-74-S) 5.2 mi.
Turn left to stay on Carlisle Rd. (road turns at a 90 degree angle), .9 miles to the test site, just before Wellsville.

WEATHER:

Be prepared for anything, but the weather is generally mild in late April and early May in Pennsylvania. The average high is 68 and the average low of 48. Layered clothing is best and don't forget appropriate footwear. April can also be a rainy month in this region.



RV PARKING:

RV PARKING and CABINS - The Host Hotel is allowing 25 RVs to park on the paved grounds. There is no electric or water hookup, but there is a Flying J directly across the street for RV service. There will be a single charge of \$25 and the space will be allotted to the first 25 registrants.

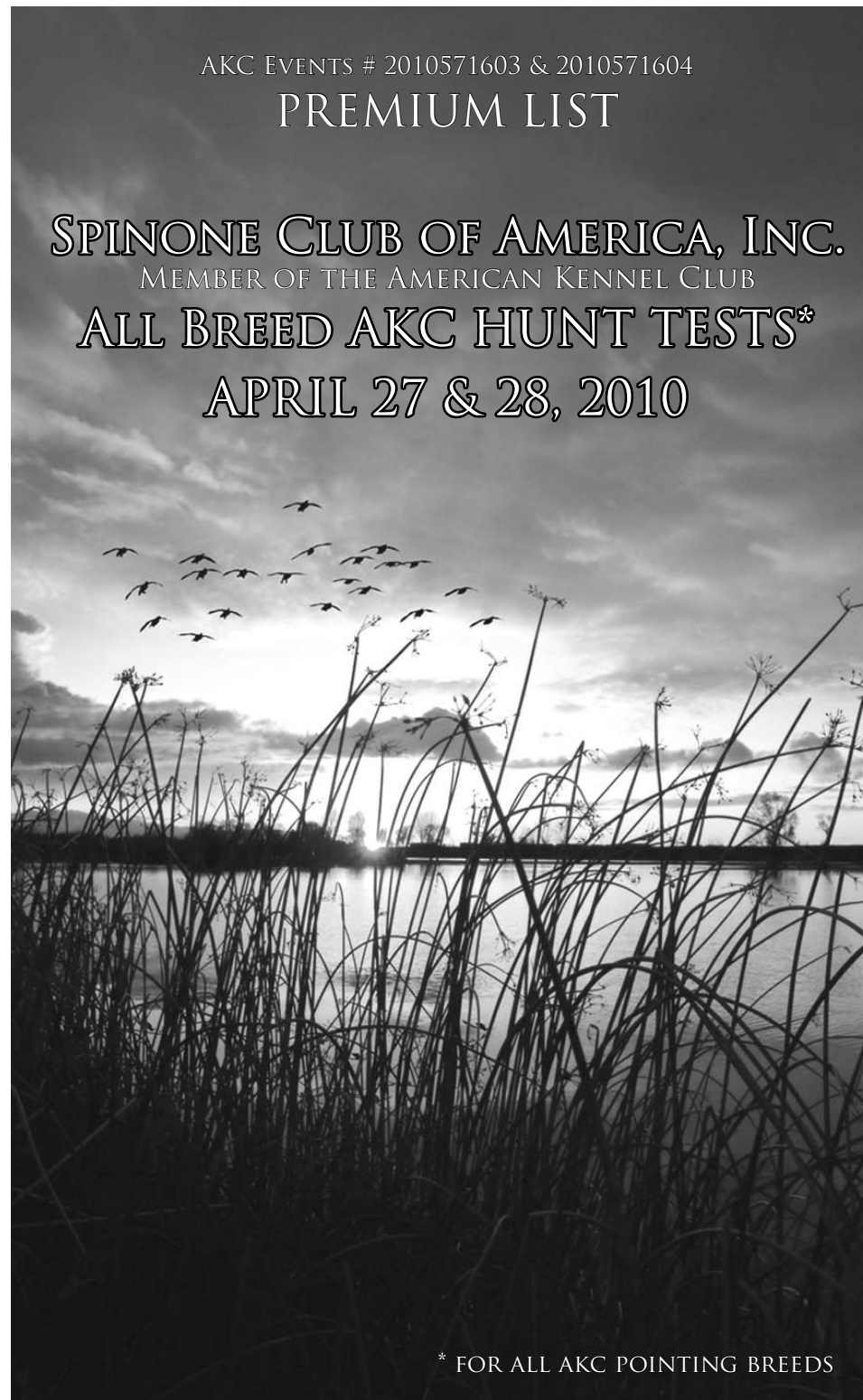
