Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Show Secretary's Office advised at once. The Show Secretary and show-giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

JUDGING/EXHIBITING

- Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

- Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

SHOW SITE

- NO PRACTICING ALLOWED IN THE RINGS AT ANY TIME.

- All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to crates except when being judged or in an exercise pen.

- No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of judging.

- All persons attending this dog show hereby waive any claim for damages against the Spinone Club of America and its members, in the event that a motor vehicle must be entered to rescue a dog that appears to be in stress such as from overheating or suffocation due to improper ventilation.
