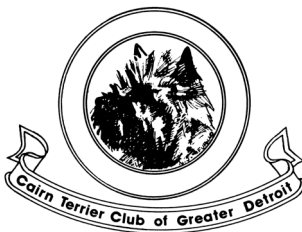

Effective May 12, 2010 AKC Grand Championship points will be awarded at the judge's discretion to: Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, First Select Dog, First Select Bitch.

Additional Judge's Select Awards (Awards of Merit) will be presented after the Best of Breed competition, at the discretion of the judge, in no particular order and in any quantity per gender, subject to the total limit. Best of Breed, Best of Winners and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed winners are excluded from additional Awards of Merit selections. The total number of Select Awards will be 10% of the total number of dogs entered in breed classes up to a maximum of four (4), and includes Grand Champion Select Dog #1 and Bitch #1.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

Entry blank MUST be filled out completely with the necessary information for the entry in Junior Showmanship to be accepted.

NOVICE CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

OPEN CLASS: For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show.

ENTRY FEE \$16 even if a second entry of the dog. Bitches in season are not eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship. At Specialty shows, dog must be of the breed for which the show is held.

NOTE: Bred By Exhibitor (BBE) Class Eligibility (AKC revision 9-02):

1. All dogs entered in the Bred by Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC, as of the date of closing for the show.
2. The person handling the dog must be both a breeder of record and an owner of record of the dog.
3. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES - SINGLE DOG ENTRIES (Classes for Dogs and Bitches)

Veteran Classes - for Dogs and Bitches: • 7 yrs and older, under 10 yrs old • 10 yrs and over

NOTE: AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows. Chapter 11. Section 8. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veterans Classes only at independent specialties and/or those all-breed shows which do not offer any competitive classes beyond Best of Breed. This is an independent specialty.

ENTRY FEE \$20.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES - MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

Stud Dog Class - For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog class and shown in the ring with his Get. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the Regular Classes at the first entry fee of \$28, or in the non-regular Veteran Class with 'Stud Dog' class indicated on the entry form in the space for additional classes at an additional \$20. Or, the Stud Dog may be entered in Stud Dog class only for a \$20 entry fee.

The Get MUST be entered in one of the Regular Classes, but there is no additional entry fee for them as participants with their sire in this non-regular class. The Get only will be judged, on the merits of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or being excused under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy or the standard for the Breed.

NOTE: AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows. Chapter 11. Section 8. A castrated male may be entered as Stud Dog in the Stud Dog Class and a spayed bitch may be entered as Brood Bitch in the Brood Bitch Class.

Brood Bitch Class - Same as Stud Dog Class except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog, Produce for Get.

How to Use the Entry Form for These Shows

USE ONE ENTRY BLANK PER DOG ONLY IF INFORMATION IS
EXACTLY THE SAME FOR EACH DAY.

Carefully check the box(es) for each show in which you wish to enter your dog.

You **MUST** use separate entry blanks if you are entering your dog in a different class on different days. (e.g. Open Class on Day 1 and Bred By Exhibitor Class on Day 2 - use 2 entry forms).

If you are entering an *additional* class on one of the days but not the other, use 2 entry forms (e.g. Open Class on Day 1, and Open Class plus Jr. Showmanship on Day 2).

ON LINE ENTRIES

If entering on the SDS website, you may enter both shows on the same form. Just indicate **BOTH** show dates in the 'Date' field. Don't forget to add the \$3 processing fee to your PayPal or Credit/ Debit card payment. Be sure to print a copy of your entry prior to hitting the 'Submit' button.

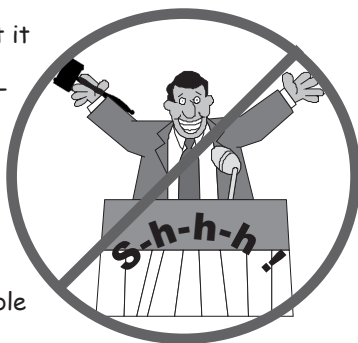
