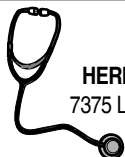
RV PARKING

*Additional AWARDS OF MERIT will be given for the recognition of dogs and/or bitches competing in Best of Breed Competition that are not awarded Best of Breed, Best of Winners, or Best of Opposite Sex - at the judge's option, in any quantity by sex up to a maximum of five (5) including the Grand Champion Select Dog #1 and Bitch #1.

PLEASE NOTE: All trophies and prizes (including MONETARY prizes) will be awarded in the judging ring to the person exhibiting the dog, who will be considered to be the owner or agent of the owner. All claims for trophies and other prizes must be made in the judging ring before the completion of the judging of the breed, and the Show Chairperson advised at once in the event of any discrepancy. No award will be mailed. In the event a prize is not available, the GLAMC reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

Junior Showmanship

The bottom back of the entry form MUST be filled out with the Junior's information, including AKC number, in order for the entry to be accepted. Call the American Kennel Club to obtain a number, (919) 816-3595. At specialty shows, the dog handled must be of the breed for which the show is held. There must be competition in order for Best Junior to be awarded. BITCHES IN SEASON ARE NOT PERMITTED. **NOVICE CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have not won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show. **OPEN CLASS:** For Boys and Girls who are at least 9 years and under 18 years old on the day of the show and who, at the time entries close, have won three First Places, with competition present, in a Novice Class at a licensed or member show. Juniors which according to their records have completed the requirements to compete in the Open class but whose status is unconfirmed by the AKC are limited to competing in the Open Class for a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the Junior completed the requirements according to their records.

NOTES FOR ALL EVENTS

- **All dogs present must be held on leash** or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.
- **Unlimited outside crating** is available adjacent to the rings. All outdoor shelters, ex-pens, canopies must be at least 30 feet from the rings. All shelters/canopies must be securely staked. Locations of private ex-pens are at the discretion of the Show Committee.
- **CELL PHONES must be turned off or set to vibrate** while inside the ring and within 20 feet of any of the rings.

NOTE: Amateur-Owner-Handler – For dogs that are at least 6 months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog, and this class is limited to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler (eff.1-1-09)

NOTE: Bred By Exhibitor (BBE) Class Eligibility (AKC revision 9-02)

1. All dogs entered in Bred by Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC, as of the date of the show.
2. The person handling the dog must be both a breeder of record and an owner of record of the dog.
3. To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES - SINGLE DOG ENTRIES

Veteran Dog Class and Veteran Bitch Class. For dogs 8 years of age and older. Only winners of these classes will be eligible for Best of Breed competition. Entry fee is \$27 as a first entry, \$23 as a second entry.

- Veteran 8 - 10 years
- Veteran 10 - 12 years
- Veteran 12 years and older

NOTE: AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows. Chapter 11. Section 8. Neutered dogs and spayed bitches are allowed to compete in Veterans Classes only at independent specialties and/or those all-breed shows which do not offer any competitive classes beyond Best of Breed. This is an independent specialty.
